THE IMPORTANCE OF LOVE

1. WITHOUT LOVE ALLTHAT <u>I SAY IS INEFFECTIVE</u>

If I could speak all the languages of earth and of angels, but didn't love others, I would only be a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal" I Corinthians 13:1 (NLT)

"By speaking the truth in a spirit of love, we must grow up in every way to Christ, who is the head." Ephesians 4:15 (GN)

2. WITHOUT LOVE ALL THAT I KNOW IS INCOMPLETE

"If I had the gift of prophecy, and if I understood all of God's secret plans and possessed all knowledge ... <u>but didn't love others</u>, I would be nothing." 1 Corinthians 13:2 (NLT)

"Knowledge puffs up, while love builds up" I Corinthians 8:1 (NIV)

3. WITHOUT LOVE ALL THAT <u>I BELIEVE IS INSUFFICIENT</u>

"... If I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing." 1 Corinthians 13:2b (NIV)

"... The only thing that counts is faith <u>expressing itself through love</u>." Galatians 5:6 (NIV)

4. WITHOUT LOVE ALL THAT I GIVE IS INSIGNIFICANT

"If <u>I gave everything I have</u> to the poor ... but if I didn't love others, I would have gained nothing." 1 Corinthians 13:3a (NLT)

5. WITHOUT LOVE ALL THAT <u>I ACCOMPLISH HAS NO REAL VALUE</u>

"If I were burned alive for preaching the Gospel, but I didn't love others, it would be of no value whatever." 1 Corinthians 13:3b (NLT)

Description of a Loving Lifestyle
