1. IF WE WANT GOD'S BLESSING, WE MUST PRAY FOR GOD'S POWER

"They all <u>met together</u> and were <u>constantly united in prayer</u> with a <u>single purpose</u> in mind ... <i>"Acts 1:14 (NLT+CEV)

"When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a noise <u>like</u> <u>a strong</u>, <u>blowing wind</u> came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw <u>something like flames of fire</u> that were separated and stood <u>over each</u> <u>person</u> there. They were all <u>filled with the Holy Spirit</u>, and they began to speak different languages <u>by the power the Holy Spirit was giving them</u>." Acts 2:1-4 (NCV)

"Everyone was <u>filled with awe</u> at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles" Acts 2:43 (NIV)

"All the believers <u>devoted themselves</u> to the apostles' teaching..." Acts 2:42a (NLT)

"They spent their time learning from the apostles, and <u>they were like family to each</u> <u>other.</u> They also broke bread and prayed together." Acts 2:42 (CEV)

"All the believers continued together in close fellowship" Acts 2:44 (GN)

"All the believers lived in wonderful harmony" Acts 2:44 (MSG)

"They worshiped together at the Temple each day, <u>met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity." Acts 2:46 (NLT)</u>

4. IF WE WANT GOD'S BLESSING, WE MUST WORSHIP WITH INTENSE JOY

"They continued to <u>WORSHIP TOGETHER</u> in the TEMPLE COURTS... <u>PRAISING</u> God and <u>ENJOYING</u> the favor of all the people." Acts 2:46-47 (NIV+NLT)

"You have shown me the paths that lead to life, and your presence will fill me with joy!" Acts 2:28 (GN)

Therefore my heart is <u>glad</u> and my tongue r<u>ejoices</u>; my body also will rest in <u>hope</u>" Acts 2:26 (NIV)

"People <u>liked what they SAW</u>. So <u>every day their number grew</u> as God added those who were saved." Acts 2:47 (MSG)
