I. THE BELIEVER’S BILL OF RIGHTS

1. SPIRITUAL FREEDOM IS HAVING A CLEAR CONSCIENCE

“God has purchased our FREEDOM with His blood and has forgiven ALL our sins.”
Colossians 1:14 (NLT)

“By the death of Christ we are set FREE, that is, our sins are forgiven!” Ephesians 1:7 (GN)

“The Lord redeems His servants; NO ONE will be condemned who takes refuge in Him.” Psalm 34:22 (NIV)

“God will KEEP you ... FREE from ALL blame on the great day when our Lord Jesus Christ returns.” 1 Corinthians 1:8 (NLT)

“I will forgive their wickedness, and I will never again remember their sins.” Hebrews 8:12 (NLT)

2. SPIRITUAL FREEDOM MEANS PERSONAL ACCESS TO GOD

“In Christ and through faith in Him we may approach God with FREEDOM and confidence.”
Ephesians 3:12 (NIV)

“Let us therefore approach the throne of grace with fullest confidence, that we may receive mercy for our failures and grace to help in the hour of need.” Hebrews 4:16 (Ph.)

3. SPIRITUAL FREEDOM MEANS LIVING WITH MEANING AND PURPOSE

4. SPIRITUAL FREEDOM IS HAVING NO FEAR OF DEATH OR THE DEVIL

II. HOW TO LIVE FREE
