1. <u>SELFISHNESS</u> DESTROYS RELATIONSHIPS

"The greedy stir up <u>conflict</u>. Selfishness only causes <u>trouble</u>. You are much better off to trust the Lord" Proverbs 28:25 (NIV+GN)

<u>SELFLESSLESSNESS</u> BUILDS THEM.

"Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too." Philippians 2:4 (NLT)

"The person who plants selfishness, ignoring the needs of others – and ignoring God – harvests a crop of weeds. All he'll have to show for his life is weeds! But the one who plants <u>in response to God</u>, letting <u>God's</u> <u>Spirit do the growth work in him</u>, harvests a crop of real life, and eternal life." Galatians 6:7-8 (Mes)

"Live freely, animated and motivated by God's Spirit. Then you won't feed the compulsions of selfishness." Gal. 5:16 (Mes)

2. <u>PRIDE</u> DESTROYS RELATIONSHIPS

"Pride will destroy a person: a proud attitude leads to ruin." Proverbs 16:18 (NCV)

HUMILITY BUILDS THEM
