PSALM 23

"THE LORD IS MY SHEPHERD, I have everything I need. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in the right paths for his name's sake. Even when I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me! <u>YOUR ROD AND</u> <u>YOUR STAFF COMFORT ME</u>. You prepare a banquet for me in front of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil, and my cup overflows. Surely goodness and mercy will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever!"

WHAT'S A ROD & A STAFF?

• A ROD is a tool for <u>PROTECTING</u>, which represents POWER & AUTHORITY

• A STAFF is a tool for <u>GUIDING</u>, which represents <u>CARE & COMPASSION</u>

"Jesus is the GREAT SHEPHERD of the sheep." Hebrews 13:20b (NIV)

Jesus: "I came so that <u>my sheep will have life</u> and <u>everything they need</u>. I AM the <u>GOOD SHEPHERD</u>! <i>The good shepherd <u>gives His life for His sheep</u>." John 10:10b-11 (GW)

HOW DOES JESUS TAKE CARE OF HIS SHEEP?

1. JESUS SHOWS ME <u>COMPASSION</u>, IF I BRING HIM MY HURTS

"When Jesus saw the crowds, He was <u>moved with compassion</u> for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like <u>sheep without a shepherd</u>." Matthew 9:36 (BSB)

"For even I, the Messiah, am not here to be served, but to help others, and to give my life as a ransom for many." Mark 10:45 (LB)

2. JESUS <u>LEADS</u> ME IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION, IF I CHOOSE TO FOLLOW HIM "[The Good Shepherd] leads me in the <u>right paths</u> for His name's sake." Psalm 23:3b (NRSV)

Jesus: "(The Good Shepherd) <u>walks ahead</u> of the sheep; and they <u>follow Him</u>, for they recognize His voice." John 10:4 (LB)

"Lord, Your constant love is my guide; your faithfulness always leads me." Psalm 26:3 (GN)

3. JESUS <u>RESCUES & RECOVERS</u> ME, IF I FAIL OR FALL

Jesus said, "If any of you has a sheep and <u>it falls into a pit</u> on the Sabbath, will you not rescue it and lift it out? <u>How much more valuable</u> is a man than a sheep!" Matthew 12:11-12a (NIV)

"You never need to be afraid of sudden disaster or hidden troubles that ensnare the wicked, for the Lord is your security. He will keep you safe and keep your foot from getting caught in a trap." Proverbs 3:25-26 (NLT)

"My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they will <u>never</u> die, and <u>NO ONE</u> can steal them out of my hand. My Father gave my sheep to me. He is greater than all, and <u>no person can steal</u> my sheep out of my <u>Father's hand</u>." John 10:27-29 (NCV)
